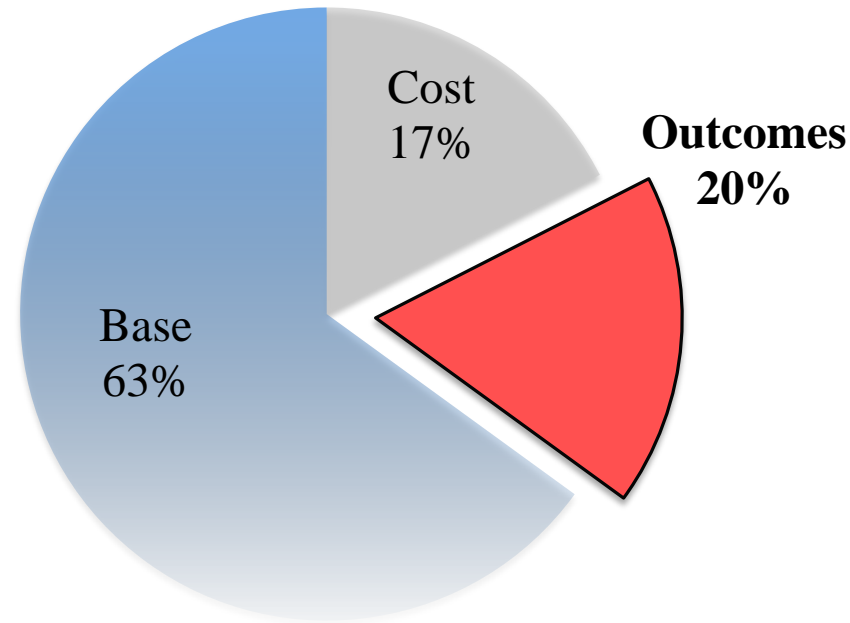

A function of Academic & Student Affairs

Outcomes Metrics

- **Retention and Progression**
- **# Completers**
- Enrollment and Completion of students on **Pell**
- **# Undergraduate Adult Completers** age ≥ 25
- **# Students cross-enrolled** at 2 & 4yr institutions
- **# Transfers** from 2 to 4yr institutions
- **# Completers** leading to **4 or 5 star jobs**
- **\$ Grant-funded** research
- **Time-to-award** for students: **Associate**
- **Time-to-award** for students: **Baccalaureate**

- Catalog & Web Communication – Program offerings
- Curriculum Logic – and Degree Paths
- Prerequisites – and Student Advising
- Corequisites – starting with the right course for the student (especially math)
- Academic Policy & Practice – admission, orientation, attendance, academic action
