Dear Commissioner Nichols:

This correspondence transmits the required initial postsecondary education formula funding budget request for FY 2013-2014. Per your request, the enclosed schedule summarizes the State funding needed if the funding formula requirements were to be fully met. This is a preliminary estimate which will be revised in early Spring 2013 when fall course completions, peer data and current space utilization are updated.

We understand that this submission is the first step in a process that will end next summer when the Governor and Legislature agree on a final budget for 2013-14. Further, we realize that the financial realities facing the state will require all state agencies to become even more efficient.

The enclosed initial funding request reflects several factors that should be considered:

- 1. Performance components of the formula designed to incentivize improved performance include:
 - A fully funded base core cost request that incentivizes progression increase of \$298.5 million
 - Performance pool that rewards progress towards master plan objectives increase of \$36 million
 - Enrollment Growth/Stabilization Pool increase of \$24 million
- 2. Funding in the amount of \$44.2 million for the "specialized units" (health sciences centers, law centers, and the LSU Agriculture Center) using the traditional formula funding approach. These factors account for \$402.7 million in additional State funding, essentially the total of a fully funded formula for postsecondary education. It is our
